Summary of 53rd Biennial Convention of the Michigan Professional Fire Fighters Union

The 53rd Biennial Convention of the Michigan Professional Fire Fighters Union was held on May 8-9, 2018, at the DoubleTree Hotel in Bay City, Michigan.

One hundred and ninety-two (192) delegates, thirty-seven (37) alternates, and eighty-two (82) guests, vendors, and speakers attended the Convention. The delegates represented seventy-one (71) locals. In addition, one (1) local (Farmington Hills) was represented by proxy.

Christopher Reynolds, MPFFU 1st/3rd District Vice President, served as master of ceremonies for the opening session. The Honor Guard consisting of Bill Case-Bay City, Chris Lince-Midland, and Gary McDonald-Saginaw opened the convention with the presentation of colors. Jessica Goik from Cramer Middle School sang the National Anthem. The bagpiper was Ian Kushnir. The invocation was delivered by Chaplin Rick Donahue.

Delegates adopted thirteen (13) Resolutions. Two of the resolutions that were adopted had cost factors totaling twelve cents (\$0.12).

*\$0.02 - Appointment of an Ad-hoc Committee to review MPFFU organization and structure.

*\$0.10 – Appointment of an Affiliation Committee to develop and implement strategies to increase MPFFU membership.

A **CPI** increase of **\$0.30** is scheduled to take place on July 1, 2018.

On June 30, 2018, eighteen cents (\$0.18) of per capita is scheduled to sunset, therefore effective July 1, 2018, the MPFFU monthly per capita will be \$14.42.

Additional Resolutions were passed that will:

- Lower the maximum number of members local pays per capita on from 401 to 300.
- Remove or update obsolete our out of date language in the MPFFU Constitution and Bylaws.
- Increase the daily compensation rate for MPFFU Committee Members, MPFFU District Vice Presidents, MPFFU Trustees, and MPFFU Instructors.
- Increase the salaries of the MPFFU President and Secretary-Treasurer
- Make the MPFFU Trustee's non-voting members of the MPFFU Executive Board
- Mandate a Biennial review of MPFFU Compensation rates.

- Create a Committee to Increase the Involvement of Retired MPFFU Members
- Urge Locals to adopt provisions for Active-Retirees in their locals and to create an active-Retiree provision in the MPFFU.

Nominations were taken, and Elections were held for two-year terms for all MPFFU Executive Board and Trustee positions.
