# An Overview of the Duties and Responsibilities of MPFFU Standing Committees

## MPFFU Behavioral Health Committee

The responsibilities of this committee shall include research into behavioral health issues, advocate for positive behavioral health for MPFFU members and retirees, the coordination of MPFFU member Peer Support Teams and other duties as related or assigned by the MPFFU Executive Board relating to fire fighter behavioral health.

## **MPFFU Public Relations Committee**

The responsibilities of this committee include utilizing all forms of MPFFU social media and websites to aggressively promote the career opportunities and benefits of being a career fulltime firefighter or fulltime firefighter/paramedic. In addition, the committee is tasked to put additional emphasis on expanding the visibility of the MPFFU on all social media platforms and other related duties as assigned by the MPFFU Executive Board.

## MPFFU Safety and Health Committee

The responsibilities of this committee will include monitoring and sharing the latest issues and treads impacting the safety and health of our members.

## MPFFU EMS Committee

The responsibilities of this committee will include a multitude of tasks, including but not limited to ensuring that the MPFFU and its members have a voice in any State level decisions impacting MFR's, EMTs, and Paramedics.

#### **MPFFU Union Education Committee**

The responsibilities of this committee will include but not be limited to developing and providing training and education on the issues local union officers need to be successful in the performance of their duties.

## MPFFU Political Education Committee

The responsibilities of this committee will include but not be limited to assisting with MPFFU lobbying efforts with elected officials in Lansing, assisting locals with improving their interaction with local elected officials, and increasing members involvement with the MPFFU Fire PAC.
