Redford Fire and Rescue provides a full range of services to the 48,000 residents of our 11 square mile community. Redford Township borders Detroit, Southfield, Dearborn Heights, Livonia, Farmington Hills, Garden City, and Westland. A combination of residential, light industrial and large manufacturing occupancies along with major thoroughfares including US 24 and I-96 represent daily protection needs reflected in the nearly 5000 alarms responded to in 2012. The department is comprised of 36 Officers and Firefighters in the Suppression Division, 3 Administrative Officers and administrative assistant operating out of 3 fire stations. The Fire Department has undergone significant operational, technological and infrastructure improvement in 2013, due in no small part to the support of the residents of our fine community.
